



# Grants for Community Projects

## Sponsored by Pheasants Forever's Leopold Education Project and the Aldo Leopold Foundation

The goal of our community grants is to foster the spirit of Aldo Leopold and his conservation ethic in communities through hands-on activities in which participants learn firsthand about Leopold's land ethic, experience his writings and apply his teachings.

### Grant Guidelines:

- Five grants of up to \$500 will be awarded to qualified applicants who submit a proposal that best meets the criteria for an eligible project (see below).
- Project must be planned within one year and completed within two years.
- A final report must be submitted within one month of completing the project.
- Grant deadline is April 1, 2010.

### Eligible projects:

Applicants must plan to do one of the following:

- Host a Leopold event in your community that introduces participants to the writings and philosophy of Aldo Leopold and engages them in activities that foster a deeper understanding of Leopold's messages.
- Develop and/or enhance a schoolyard/community habitat or an outdoor classroom.
- Offer a Leopold Education Project Workshop in your community.

### Grant procedure:

1. Submit a proposal, not to exceed three pages, for one of the eligible projects.
2. Include in the proposal the following:
  - a. Title
  - b. Description of project, including what it is, when and where it will be held or completed, participants and specific objectives/outcomes.
  - c. Overall budget and specifically how grant monies will be used.
  - d. Timeline for project.
  - e. Partners that will be involved.
  - f. Contact person and all contact information. Be sure to include email address.
